Rehearsal Rooms	Only essential persons should be in the room. Careful planning of the rehearsal process is required to keep numbers in the room to the absolute minimum	Cleaning protocol for Covid 19 – assessment should be undertaken to look at areas such as toilets, pinch points for movement and touch points, such as doors and handles. • Increased Hand sanitiser stations at entrances and exits, along with plentiful supplies of hand washing soaps within the toilets. Individuals are to wash their hands thoroughly and use hand sanitisers provided	SVFC	
	Scripts should be provided for each individual. The sharing of scripts / libretto should not be permitted within rehearsals. This must also be adhered to in performance settings as well as the rehearsal room	:	SVFC	
	Leaving the rehearsal rooms. Staggered leaving should be considered, with those rehearsing leaving in single file (or in family groups). This will reduce the amount of passing taking place. People should be encouraged not to stay and chat within the rehearsal rooms.		SVFC
